

## **INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA**

### ***WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT?***

The purpose of this document is to provide you, in accordance with Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC ("GDPR"), with information on the conditions under which the processing of the personal data provided by you will be carried out.

### ***WHO WILL PROCESS YOUR PERSONAL DATA?***

The controller of personal data is E4S Czech, s. r. o., with registered office at Krabošická 59, 251 01 Vodňárky - Říčany, ID No.: 17265371, registered in the Commercial Register maintained by the Municipal Court in Prague, under file No. C 369136. Furthermore, based on your consent, the Faculty of Physical Education and Sport of Charles University, with the registered office at José Martího 269/31, 162 52 Prague 6, ID No.: 00216208, may be the processor of your personal data. ### ***WHY WILL THE CONTROLLER PROCESS YOUR PERSONAL DATA?***

By creating a registration, i.e. filling in the form for the GSPORT League of Universities, you have become our customer/member of the GSPORT League of Universities. In order to fulfil the purpose of the GSPORT University League legal relationship, it is necessary to process your personal data, where the purpose of the processing of personal data is to provide a service to registered GSPORT University League players and to participate in GSPORT University League tournaments and events (hereinafter collectively also referred to as the "Service"). In order to provide this service to you, we need to work with your personal data.

On the basis of your consent, as set out below, we will then process your personal data, for example, for the purpose of promoting the GSPORT University League or publishing it on social media, the specific purpose will always be stated in the consent.

### ***WHAT PERSONAL DATA WILL THE CONTROLLER PROCESS AND WHAT IS THE LEGAL BASIS FOR THIS PROCESSING?***

For the purpose of fulfilling its contractual obligations and providing the above-mentioned service, the Controller processes your personal data listed below, including any updates made by you, as well as the date and time of registration and its eventual termination.

In some cases, we may also process personal data in the context of our legitimate interest. However, this interest shall never take precedence over the interests and fundamental rights of the data subject requiring the protection of his or her personal data. Legitimate interest is a legal basis for us under Article 6(1)(f) GDPR, in particular in situations where we are protecting our assets, our economic interests and our reputation, should we need to initiate and conduct legal or arbitration proceedings.

In particular, **the controller** processes your personal data as follows:

- identification data (name, surname);
- contact data (e-mail address, contact postal address, telephone number);
- the member's player nickname;

- registration photo;
- the name of the university that the GSPORT University League member attends;
- age, weight and height;
- date of birth;
- IP address;
- registration details (time);
- other data relevant to the processing purposes described above.
- Other personal data based on your consent.

**The controller** does not process special category personal data.

As stated above in some cases we may only collect and process your personal data with your explicit and free consent. You may withdraw your consent at any time by the contact details provided in this policy or in the consent. The specific terms and conditions for the use of your personal data after consent is given are always set out in each individual consent.

### **WHO WILL HAVE ACCESS TO YOUR PERSONAL DATA?**

The Controller declares that only relevant employees of the Controller will have access to your personal data, who are entrusted with tasks related to the purpose of processing your personal data and the operator the controller's website (<https://e4sczech.cz>). Any further information about the processors will be provided to you upon request. Eventually, based on your consent, the processors who are entrusted with tasks related to the purpose of processing your personal data in the given consent.

### **WILL YOUR PERSONAL DATA BE TRANSFERRED OUTSIDE THE EU?**

Your personal data may be transferred to us in exceptional cases, in particular in connection with international GSPORT University League's activities in international sports organisations, they may be transferred to contracting partners (processors) based in third countries, in particular in the UK. Personal data may be transferred to a third country, i.e. outside the European Union, for the purpose of processing. In this case, your personal data is transferred for processing in accordance with and subject to the terms and conditions of GDPR, i.e. only to so-called safe third countries in accordance with applicable European Commission decisions an adequate level of data protection or on the basis of appropriate safeguards or binding corporate rules pursuant to Articles 46 and 47 of the GDPR. However, we take every precaution to comply with all obligations, that arise for us from the transfer.

### **HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR PERSONAL DATA?**

Throughout the duration of the relationship on the basis of which we are authorised to process your personal data and subsequently for the period necessary to secure legal claims arising from the contract, i.e. until, until such time as our mutual rights and obligations may become the subject of litigation. With regard to statute of limitations, we will retain your personal data for a period of 10 years after the termination of the contractual relationship. V after the termination of the contractual relationship, the legal basis for this processing will be the legitimate interest of our of the company to protect their rights and to prove the fulfilment of contractual obligations. If we process your personal data on the basis of your consent, the processing period is as follows in the consent in question.

### **WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS IN RELATION TO THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA?**

As a data subject, you have in particular:

- a) The right of access to personal data, on the basis of this right, upon your request we will provide you with information on what personal data we process, for what purpose, from the source from which the personal data was obtained, to whom your data was provided and what is the intended period for which it will be stored.

- b) The right to rectification, meaning that you can request that we delete without undue delay personal data concerning you and the right to have incomplete personal data completed.
- c) The right to erasure, you can also ask us to delete personal data about you that are no longer we do not need to delete. You also have the right to have us without undue delay delete your personal data if you withdraw your consent. However, we can only comply with your request if we no longer need to process the personal data. We cannot therefore process the personal data delete it, for example, if the statutory archiving period for certain documents expires etc. We will, of course, explain this to you in response to your request. You will find the following in the GDPR right under Article 17.
- d) Right to restriction of processing of your personal data, we will restrict the processing of your personal data upon your request the processing of personal data about which there is a problem or dispute - e.g. whether they are personal data is accurate, whether the processing is unlawful, etc. During the period of restriction of processing, your personal data may only be stored and otherwise only processed on the basis of your consent, for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims or for public interest. This right is enshrined in Article 18 GDPR.
- e) The right to data portability if we process your personal data electronically form, you can ask us to transfer them to another controller. If this is the case in a particular specific case, we will transfer your personal data on the basis of your request.
- f) The right not to be subject to any decision based solely on automated processing.
- g) The right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, which is the Data Protection Authority, see contact details below.
